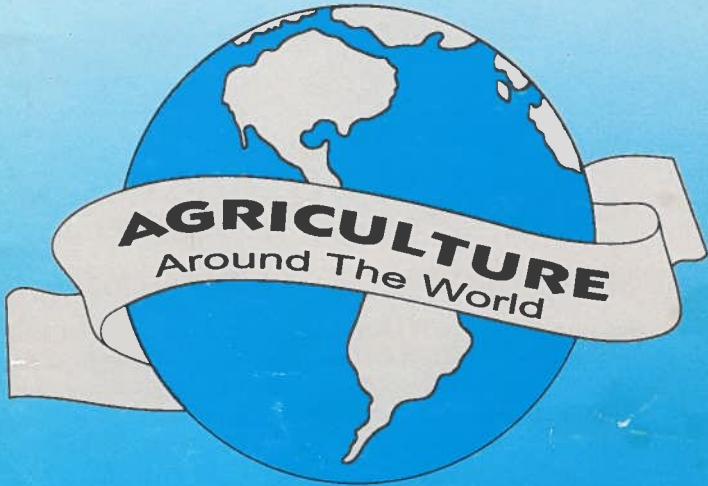

Two and three-year-old colts may be shown in harness as teams. Teams and Single Horses in harness must be shown hitched to a suitable four-wheeled vehicle. Stallions cannot be shown in Harness

DRIVERS MAY BE REQUIRED TO DRIVE A COURSE

*Exhibitor Plus One Helper (ONLY) Allowed Through Gate With No Admission Charge

Exhibitors must bring their horses promptly when called. Be sure and check the time schedule for judging.

Entry Fee - 15% deducted from prize winners.

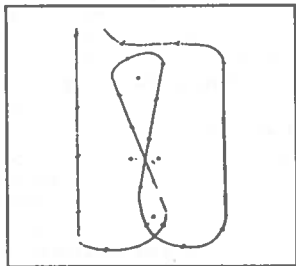
