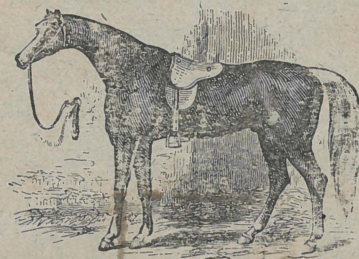

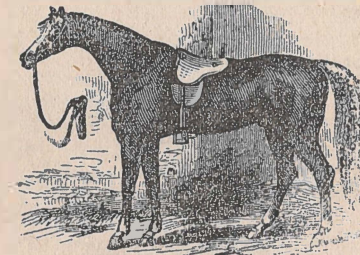

RULES & REGULATIONS.

- 1.—The Show open to subscribers within the County of Haldimand.
- 2.—No Competitor will be entitled to a premium if the Judges deem the stock or article unworthy of the same.
- 3.—No less than two bushels of each kind of grain must be shown, unless otherwise specified in the bills, and the grain and roots must be the growth of 1887, and grown by the competitor.
- 4.—All entries to be made before 11 o'clock a.m., for which purpose the Secretary will attend at the Town Hall, York, from 7 to 11 o'clock a.m., on the day of Show.
- 5.—All persons wishing to become members for the present season can do so by paying the sum of \$1.00.
- 6.—All products to be the growth of parties exhibiting the same, and grown within the County of Haldimand.
- 7.—Farm Horses to be shown before lumber wagons, in farm harness.
- 8.—No animal or article to be shown twice.
- 9.—No animal to be allowed to compete as a three-year-old cow, unless she has had a calf, or evident she is in calf.
- 10.—None but manufacturers or their agents must exhibit Agricultural Implements, and this class to be open to the Province.
- 11.—All prizes to be taken up before the 1st day of January, 1888, or otherwise forfeited.
- 12.—Any person interfering, by conversation or otherwise, with the Judges, until after judgment is passed, shall have no prizes awarded them.
- 13.—All the exhibitors must be the *bona fide* owners of animals or articles exhibited.
- 14.—No second premium will be given to any person for the same kind of Agricultural produce.
- 15.—The exhibitor's name not to be on the bag, etc., in which his produce is exhibited.
- 16.—No article to be removed from the Hall until after 4 p.m.
- 17.—The Secretary will receive entries by mail up to October 1st.
- 18.—Judges may recommend articles though not on the prize list, and the Directors will take the same into consideration.
- 19.—The Directors will take every precaution, under the circumstances, to insure the safety of articles in the Hall.
- 20.—Admission to the Grounds, 10 cents—each member will be furnished with two tickets.
- 21.—All domestic or fancy articles must be the work of the exhibitor, otherwise the prize money will be forfeited.
- 22.—Certificates or card of pedigree Durham Cattle must be produced to the Judges at the time of exhibition if called for.
