Caledonia Canada Day Lottery Rules of Play

Draw Scheduling & Prizing

Ticket sales start on Friday, May 1, 2026, at 12:00am and end on Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 9:30pm. Tickets are \$5 each.

Grand Prize Details

- The grand prize deadline of eligibility is 9:30pm on Wednesday, July 1, 2026.
- The grand prize winner will be drawn at approximately 9:45pm on Wednesday, July 1, 2026, with the winner being announced on Wednesday, July 1, 2026 at approximately 10:00pm.
- The grand prize winner will receive 50% of gross ticket sales.
- The draw will be made at 151 Caithness St. E., Caledonia, Ontario. N3W 1C2. Canada.

Ticket Guidelines

- Tickets will be issued in-person only and numbered from 0001 to 2000.
- All purchasers must be at least 18 years of age and be within the Province of Ontario at the time of purchase.
- The total tickets available in the lottery will be 2000.
- All inquiries, if any, regarding the *chances of winning* are to be made to the Caledonia Agricultural Society prior to the purchase of tickets. Chances of winning depend on the number of tickets sold.
- Tickets are non-refundable. Ticket purchases are not income tax deductible. Prizes are tax-exempt.
- All ticket holders have the right to witness the draw.
- The winning ticket number will be selected by a random draw and all eligible tickets will be included.
- Prizes will be awarded to the primary ticket holder (the first name that appears on the ticket) by cheque payable to the primary ticket holder. In the event of a group win, in trust win, or any win involving multiple individuals, any transfer of prizes must happen independently of the Caledonia Agricultural Society.
- The primary ticket holder will be notified by telephone or email as to what they have won and where/how to claim their prize(s).
- All winners will be posted on the Caledonia Canada day website (www.caledoniacanadaday.ca), on social media, and in email newsletters. The winner acknowledges and hereby irrevocably and in perpetuity release the right for the Caledonia Agricultural Society and/or their designees to use and/or publish the winner's first name and first initial of last name, city of residence, photographs or other likenesses, pictures, portraits, video, voice, testimonials, and/or statements made by the winner regarding the lottery or otherwise worldwide and in perpetuity for any and all purposes, including but not limited to, advertising, publicity, trade and/or promotion in any and all forms of media, now known or hereafter devised, including, but not limited to, print, television, radio, electronic, cable, social media, or world wide web, without granting further limitation, restriction, compensation, notice, review, or approval.
- The winners must sign a prize release form before the winnings are distributed. This includes first and last name, address, phone number, photo identification, and verification that they are not a staff member or board member of the Caledonia Agricultural Society.

- If the winner cannot provide photo identification, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided. All prizes will be delivered or sent to the winner via a courier or registered mail service should in-person pickup not be an option.
- The winning ticket holder has six (6) months to claim their prize from the date of the draw. Unclaimed prizes will be reported to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO), after which the prize will be donated to the Caledonia Agricultural Society on approval from the AGCO.
- The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the lottery:
 - Persons whose principal residence is outside of Ontario, Canada
 - Persons under the age of 18
 - Employees and Board Members of the Caledonia Agricultural Society
